Polish American Studies is published twice each year by the Polish American Historical Association with offices at Central Connecticut State University, 1615 Stanley Street, New Britain, CT, 06050. It is a member of the History Cooperative and JSTOR electronic databases and is abstracted and indexed in *Historical Abstracts*, *America: History and Life*, and *The Catholic Periodical and Literature Index*. Regular membership, including subscriptions to *Polish American Studies* and the *PAHA Newsletter*, is \$40 per year; student (with faculty signature) and senior citizen memberships are \$20; institutional memberships are \$98; and life memberships (available only to individuals) are \$500. Back issues are available at \$10 per issue.

Quotations or publication titles in languages other than English should be accompanied by English translations. The editors assume no responsibility in the event that a manuscript is lost.
